Chairman's Welcome

The Minutes of the previous AGM were read and approved.

<u>The Chairman's Annual Report</u> was read in which she remarked that once again the work of Spiota has been much praised and appreciated, and, in fact that we have been shortlisted for an award in the Newcastle Building Society's Cornerstone of the Community Awards. In this respect ten will be attending a reception at Wynyard Hall on the 26<sup>th</sup> November. Our Chairman pointed out that even though only ten have been invited, it is due to the hard work of all that we have been shortlisted, and all were thanked. Finally the Chairman thanked everyone for their efforts during the year, and congratulated the five members who celebrated their 80<sup>th</sup> birthdays this year.

<u>The Treasurer's Report</u> was circulated and discussed. Takings were down on the Coffee morning this year but it was felt that the event should continue if only for the publicity it affords. Also more than usual has had to be spent on new tubs. Mrs Purnell thanked Trish for her work and the report was duly adopted.
