Matters arising from previous minutes

- 1. Bulbs will be planted as soon as we receive them from Rotary and Strikes.
- 2. Angel Court now ready for re-development Caroline will sort this.
- 3. Regarding the benches new ones are to be provided in the Market Place
- 4. The Coffee Morning yielded £375.00 profit after expenses.
- 5. We have had no word as yet from Skipton Building Society re a grant.

Other Business

- 1. Thanks were expressed to Ken. Derek Lovaine and Mike for their help at Stokesley Show. Linda suggested that in future an activity should be incorporated to attract more interest.
- 2. Linda has investigated the possibility of laying astroturf on the Stokesley Motors roundabout. We understand that a reduced rate would be considered if the company were allowed to advertise.
