Matters arising from previous minutes:

The plaques are ready now.

1. New Tubs Four broken tubs have been replaced. That used the last of the tubs in stock so we need to order some more.
2. Signs. It was decided to stay with the same company, Stokesley Signs, as they donate them to SPIOTA.
3. The Ziggurat will be replaced on Friday morning. Anyone who can assist please report at 9am.
4. Tubs which are no longer sponsored will be taken out of commission. A number have collapsed and will be replaced. Two tubs will be sponsored by Cobblestones. They will be within the railings and the company will water them.
5. The Ziggurat. This summer's display has been so successful it will be repeated next year. The new troughs will be needed for the spring planting. We will need a tray for the plant at the top. Shrubs will be displayed for now.
