MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 19TH October 2015

Following the Annual General Meeting the ordinary monthly meeting was held and the Minutes of the previous meeting having been passed the matters arising were:-

1. The Ziggurat. It has been requested that this be moved for a forthcoming food fair but this request has had to be refused as this is not possible. With further regard to the market place, the weedkilling is not adequate and requires to be done more than twice a year as happens at present.
2. With regard to the winter planting, it was thought it might be helpful if the nursery could deliver a trolley load of plants to the West Green area next time.
3. It is unclear whether the poppies are to be planted in the two empty troughs or around the cenotaph this year. If the troughs are not used they will be planted after Armistice Day.
4. Hyacinth bulbs will be planted in the town centre as before and bulbs saved from last year will be planted in the next two weeks. The Library bed has been planted this week and the cubs have once again planted the stone tubs on the river bank. The baskets on the town hall will need to be removed soon
5. Letters are to be sent to all the watering helpers.
6. Ten people will be attending the Newcastle Building Society Cornerstone of the Community awards at Wynyard Hall on 26th November as Spiota have been shortlisted.
7. The New Year Lunch will be held again at Chapters Hotel on Thursday 21st January 2016.

Thursday Work – Planting of bulbs – lay gravel at the Mill Wheel site and remove weeds. Also decide whether the trees need some pruning back – Town signs – Cuprinol the tubs to smarten them – check labels.

Any other business – The dates for 2016 are as follows:- January 18th, March 14th, April 18th, May 16th, June 20th, July 18th, September 26th, October 31st, November 28th.

The meeting closed at 8.55 p.m. Next meeting November 30th 2015
